

The Day

^{NKJ} **Matthew 7:22** "Many will say to Me in that **day**, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?'

^{NKJ} **Matthew 10:15** "Assuredly, I say to you, it will be more tolerable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah in the **day** of judgment than for that city!

^{NKJ} **Matthew 11:22** "But I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon in the **day** of judgment than for you.

^{NKJ} **Matthew 11:24** "But I say to you that it shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom in the **day** of judgment than for you."

^{NKJ} **Matthew 12:36** "But I say to you that for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the **day** of judgment.

^{NKJ} **Matthew 24:36** " But of that **day** and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only.

^{NKJ} **Matthew 24:38-39** "For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the **day** that Noah entered the ark, and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.

^{NKJ} **Matthew 24:50-51** "the master of that servant will come on a **day** when he is not looking for *him* and at an hour that he is not aware of, and will cut him in two and appoint *him* his portion with the hypocrites. There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

^{NKJ} **Matthew 25:13** "Watch therefore, for you know neither the **day** nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming.

^{NKJ} **Mark 6:11** "And whoever will not receive you nor hear you, when you depart from there, shake off the dust under your feet as a testimony against them. Assuredly, I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrah in the **day** of judgment than for that city!"

^{NKJ} **Mark 13:32** " But of that **day** and hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.

^{NKJ} **Luke 10:12** "But I say to you that it will be more tolerable in that **Day** for Sodom than for that city.

^{NKJ} **Luke 12:46** "the master of that servant will come on a **day** when he is not looking for *him*, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in two and appoint *him* his portion with the unbelievers.

^{NKJ} **Luke 17:24-32** "For as the lightning that flashes out of one *part* under heaven shines to the other *part* under heaven, so also the Son of Man will be in His **day**. But first He must suffer many things and be rejected by this generation. And as it was in the days of Noah, so it will be also in the days of the Son of Man: They ate, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the **day** that Noah entered the ark, and the flood came and destroyed them all. Likewise as it was also in the days of Lot: They ate, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they built; but on the **day** that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven and destroyed *them* all. Even so will it be in the **day** when the Son of Man is revealed. In that **day**, he who is on the housetop, and his goods *are* in the house, let him not come down to take them away. And likewise the one who is in the field, let him not turn back. Remember Lot's wife.

^{NKJ} **Luke 21:34** " But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that **Day** come on you unexpectedly.

^{NKJ} **John 6:39-40** "This is the will of the Father who sent Me, that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up at the last **day**. And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last **day**."

^{NKJ} **John 6:44** "No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last **day**."

^{NKJ} **John 6:54** "Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last **day**."

^{NKJ} **John 11:24** Martha said to Him, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection at the last **day**."

^{NKJ} **John 12:48** "He who rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has that which judges him -- the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last **day**."

^{NKJ} **Acts 17:31** "because He has appointed a **day** on which He will judge the world in righteousness by the Man whom He has ordained. He has given assurance of this to all by raising Him from the dead."

^{NKJ} **Romans 2:5** But in accordance with your hardness and your impenitent heart you are treasuring up for yourself wrath in the **day** of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God,

^{NKJ} **Romans 2:16** in the **day** when God will judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ, according to my gospel.

^{NKJ} **1 Corinthians 1:8** who will also confirm you to the end, *that you may be blameless* in the **day** of our Lord Jesus Christ.

^{NKJ} **1 Corinthians 3:13** each one's work will become clear; for the **Day** will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is.

^{NKJ} **1 Corinthians 5:5** deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that his spirit may be saved in the **day** of the Lord Jesus.

^{NKJ} **2 Corinthians 1:14** (as also you have understood us in part), that we are your boast as you also *are* ours, in the **day** of the Lord Jesus.

^{NKJ} **Ephesians 4:30** And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the **day** of redemption.

^{NKJ} **Philippians 1:6** being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete *it* until the **day** of Jesus Christ;

^{NKJ} **Philippians 1:10** that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense till the **day** of Christ,

^{NKJ} **Philippians 2:16** holding fast the word of life, so that I may rejoice in the **day** of Christ that I have not run in vain or labored in vain.

^{NKJ} **1 Thessalonians 5:1-6** But concerning the times and the seasons, brethren, you have no need that I should write to you. For you yourselves know perfectly that the **day** of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night. For when they say, "Peace and safety!" then sudden destruction comes upon them, as labor pains upon a pregnant woman. And they shall not escape. But you, brethren, are not in darkness, so that this **Day** should overtake you as a thief. You are all sons of light and sons of the **day**. We are not of the night nor of darkness. Therefore let us not sleep, as others *do*, but let us watch and be sober.

^{NKJ} **2 Thessalonians 1:7-2:3** and to *give* you who are troubled rest with us when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. These shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power, when He comes, in that **Day**, to be glorified in His saints and to be admired among all those who believe, because our testimony among you was believed. Therefore we also pray always for you that our God would count you worthy of *this* calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of *His* goodness and the work of faith with power, that the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ. Now, brethren, concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him, we ask you, not to be soon shaken in mind or troubled, either by spirit or by word or by letter, as if from us, as though the **day** of Christ had come. Let no one deceive you by any means; for *that Day will not come* unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition,

^{NKJ} **2 Timothy 1:12** For this reason I also suffer these things; nevertheless I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that **Day**.

^{NKJ} **2 Timothy 1:18** The Lord grant to him that he may find mercy from the Lord in that **Day** -- and you know very well how many ways he ministered *to me* at Ephesus.

^{NKJ} **2 Timothy 4:8** Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that **Day**, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.

^{NKJ} **Hebrews 10:25** not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as *is* the manner of some, but exhorting *one another*, and so much the more as you see the **Day** approaching.

^{NKJ} **1 Peter 2:12** having your conduct honorable among the Gentiles, that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may, by *your* good works which they observe, glorify God in the **day** of visitation.

^{NKJ} **2 Peter 2:9** *then* the Lord knows how to deliver the godly out of temptations and to reserve the unjust under punishment for the **day** of judgment,

^{NKJ} **2 Peter 3:7** But the heavens and the earth *which* are now preserved by the same word, are reserved for fire until the **day** of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.

^{NKJ} **2 Peter 3:10-13** But the **day** of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up. Therefore, since all these things will be dissolved, what manner *of persons* ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness, looking for and hastening the coming of the **day** of God, because of which the heavens will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat? Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

^{NKJ} **1 John 4:17** Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the **day** of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world.

^{NKJ} **Jude 1:6** And the angels who did not keep their proper domain, but left their own abode, He has reserved in everlasting chains under darkness for the judgment of the great **day**;

^{NKJ} **Revelation 6:17** "For the great **day** of His wrath has come, and who is able to stand?"

^{NKJ} **Revelation 16:14** For they are spirits of demons, performing signs, *which* go out to the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great **day** of God Almighty.

^{NKJ} **John 5:28** "Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice ²⁹ "and come forth -- those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation.

^{NKJ} **Daniel 12:1** "At that time Michael shall stand up, The great prince who stands *watch* over the sons of your people; And there shall be a time of trouble, Such as never was since there was a nation, *Even* to that time. And at that time your people shall be delivered, Every one who is found written in the book. ² And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, Some to everlasting life, Some to shame *and* everlasting contempt. ³ Those who are wise shall shine Like the brightness of the firmament, And those who turn many to righteousness Like the stars forever and ever.

His Coming

^{NKJ} **Matthew 16:27** "For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works.

^{NKJ} **Matthew 24:3** Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will these things be? And what *will be* the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?"

^{NKJ} **Matthew 24:27** "For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.

^{NKJ} **Matthew 24:30** "Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

^{NKJ} **Matthew 24:37** "But as the days of Noah *were*, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. ³⁸ "For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the **day** that Noah entered the ark, ³⁹ "and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.

^{NKJ} **Matthew 24:42** "Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming.

^{NKJ} **Matthew 25:31** " When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him, then He will sit on the throne of His glory.

^{NKJ} **Mark 13:26** "Then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory.

^{NKJ} **Luke 12:35** " Let your waist be girded and *your* lamps burning; ³⁶ "and you yourselves be like men who wait for their master, when he will return from the wedding, that when he comes and knocks they may open to him immediately. ³⁷ "Blessed *are* those servants whom the master, when he comes, will find watching. Assuredly, I say to you that he will gird himself and have them sit down *to eat*, and will come and serve them. ³⁸ "And if he should come in the second watch, or come in the third watch, and find *them* so, blessed are those servants. ³⁹ "But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched and not allowed his house to be broken into. ⁴⁰ "Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect." ⁴¹ Then Peter said to Him, "Lord, do You speak this parable *only* to us, or to all *people*?" ⁴² And the Lord said, "Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom *his* master will make ruler over his household, to give *them their* portion of food in due season? ⁴³ "Blessed *is* that servant whom his master will find so doing when he comes. ⁴⁴ "Truly, I say to you that he will make him ruler over all that he has. ⁴⁵ "But if that servant says in his heart, 'My master is delaying his coming,' and begins to beat the male and female servants, and to eat and drink and be drunk, ⁴⁶ "the master of that servant will come on a **day** when he is not looking for *him*, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in two and appoint *him* his portion with the unbelievers.

^{NKJ} **Acts 1:11** who also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This *same* Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven."

^{NKJ} **1 Corinthians 1:7** so that you come short in no gift, eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ,

^{NKJ} **1 Corinthians 4:5** Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord comes, who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness and reveal the counsels of the hearts. Then each one's praise will come from God.

^{NKJ} **1 Corinthians 11:26** For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.

^{NKJ} **1 Corinthians 15:23** But each one in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, afterward those *who are* Christ's at His coming.

^{NKJ} **Colossians 3:4** When Christ *who is* our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory.

^{NKJ} **1 Thessalonians 2:19** For what *is* our hope, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? *Is it* not even you in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at His coming?

^{NKJ} **1 Thessalonians 3:13** so that He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all His saints.

^{NKJ} **1 Thessalonians 4:14** For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus. ¹⁵ For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive *and* remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. ¹⁶ For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first.

^{NKJ} **1 Thessalonians 5:23** Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

^{NKJ} **2 Thessalonians 2:8** And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord will consume with the breath of His mouth and destroy with the brightness of His coming. ^{NKJ} **1 Timothy 6:14** that you keep *this* commandment without spot, blameless until our Lord Jesus Christ's appearing,

^{NKJ} **2 Timothy 4:1** I charge *you* therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom:

^{NKJ} **Titus 2:13** looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,

^{NKJ} **James 5:7** Therefore be patient, brethren, until the coming of the Lord. See *how* the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, waiting patiently for it until it receives the early and latter rain. ⁸ You also be patient. Establish your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is at hand.

^{NKJ} **1 Peter 1:13** Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest *your* hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

^{NKJ} **1 Peter 4:13** but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy.

^{NKJ} **1 Peter 5:4** and when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away.

^{NKJ} **1 John 2:28** And now, little children, abide in Him, that when He appears, we may have confidence and not be ashamed before Him at His coming.

^{NKJ} **1 John 3:2** Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.

^{NKJ} **Jude 1:14** Now Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about these men also, saying, "Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints,

^{NKJ} **Revelation 1:8** "I am the Alpha and the Omega, *the* Beginning and *the* End," says the Lord, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."

^{NKJ} **Revelation 4:8** *The* four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest **day** or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!"

^{NKJ} **Revelation 22:20** He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming quickly." Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus!

Conclusions

1. The Bible speaks of a singular return of Jesus Christ.
2. The Bible speaks of this singular return of Jesus Christ including the resurrection of both the just and the unjust.

7. Christ's return is the "blessed hope" of Christ's church – of every true child of God. We shall be vindicated with Christ and shall enter into glory and eternal rest.
8. The Bible's teaching on Christ's return is often accompanied with urgent exhortations to watchfulness and eager expectation.
9. The Bible's teaching on Christ's return presents a fearful prospect for the wicked, for those not trusting now in Christ as their Lord and Savior.
